TUESDAY, MAY 14 – Last day to register to vote for the Primary Election.

Registration forms (<https://www.essexclerk.com/Forms>) must be postmarked to the County Clerk or received by Municipal Clerks. You also have the option to register online at <https://voter.svrs.nj.gov/register> by this date.

You have three options for voting: Voting early in person, on Election Day, June 4th, or via Vote By Mail.

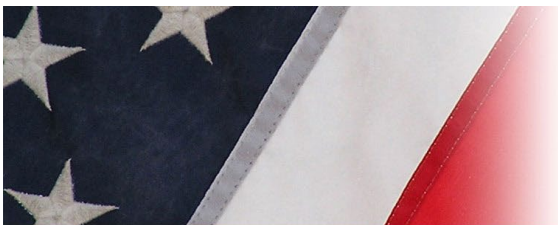
EARLY VOTING LOCATIONS

WEDNESDAY, MAY 29TH – Early Voting begins for the Primary Election and ends on Sunday, June 2nd
